7. Each entry shall be the original, unpublished work of the entrant. No discussion as to the copyright or authenticity of material shall be entered into.
8. Multiple entries are welcome, but please pay the \$10.00 fee for each entry.
9. Payment by cheque or money order only. Please make the cheque or money order payable to Catchfire Press.
10. Entry Fees: Prose: \$10 each entry, 200 - 2500 word limit.
Poetry: \$10 each entry, up to 100 line limit.
11. The closing date for the competition is 30 September 2010: only entries postmarked by 30 September 2010 are eligible for the monetary awards.
